



## ARC Audio KS125.4Mini \$999

ARC Audio remains famous for producing what are among the best car audio amplifiers available today. The drama up until now, though, was that they also had a sizeable price tag and footprint to match. ARC addressed these two issues by releasing the KS-Mini range of amplifiers. Borrowing technology from their bigger brothers, the KS-Mini amplifiers not only possess a tiny foot print (allowing them to be

mounted in all manner of places) but also output copious amounts of clean power. The KS125.4Mini gets the gong this year for its ability to produce 4 x 75 watts at 4 ohms while only having a footprint of 295mm x 130mm x 44mm. Put simply, this tiny little powerhouse produces enough power to run passive systems, active systems or even subwoofers while sounding quite superb.





## Focal SOLID4 \$629
